Lunch at Benny's Pizza

Benny's Pizza is THE gathering place for Marysville and surrounding communities. Featuring live bands year-round, two outdoor bars, a large outdoor patio for dining and socializing. Known for their fantastic pizza, wings, and house made root beer.

Length of Experience: 1.5 hours

Phoenix Bat Co

See how six pounds of wood is transformed into a baseball bat, as you learn the history of this growing business (hint: they blame it on a bunch of guys playing baseball in the 1800s). Tour the factory and see first-hand the art of crafting a great bat (including wood selection, computer-aided design, and finishing process). Visitors leave ready to hit a home run with their own mini bat souvenir in-hand.

Length of Experience: 1 hour

Covered Bridges of Union County

Sit back, relax, and let a seasoned guide navigate the pastoral countryside on a tour of the covered bridges of Union County. Four of the bridges are historic (constructed in the 1800s) and were built by local resident Reuben Partridge, a prolific builder who built well over 100 bridges in Ohio.

Length of Experience: 1- 1.5 hour, depending

Dinner on the Bridge

Participate in a truly unique experience of dining on a covered bridge, complete with delicious cuisine, entertainment, and a setting sure to celebrate a slower era. Picturesque Pottersburg Bridge, built around 1868, has become the venue for our signature covered bridge lunches and dinners, which are always a delight for the senses.
